COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during the month included the robbery and beating of a restaurant employee who was making a home delivery, and an incident of a juvenile being assaulted and robbed. Investigation continues in both cases. Five recent armed robberies in Burnaby and immediate areas were solved with the arrest of two persons by Burnaby Detachment during the month. Subjects are before the courts.

Investigation into two rapes reported this month continues, while two others were proven to be unfounded. We are pleased to report that this month we are free of traffic fatalities in the Municipality, after unfortunately having experienced a number during the past several months.

Escapes during the month numbered 2.
