COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during January included an Attempted Murder charge, which involved the use of a knife by the culprit.

After extensive investigation, a total of 61 Breaking & Entry cases were solved, with the arrest of 2 persons found to be responsible for 47 B. & E.'s; and a second 2 persons being responsible for 14. Some of the cases date back to September, 1976.

There was an incident of a sniper, who was shooting out of an apartment, hitting a police vehicle twice. He was arrested after some hours of speaking with him and was subsequently overpowered.

The arrest of a suspect, after a continual, lengthy investigation, resulted in 30 charges being laid for Rape and Indecent Assaults, committed in Burnaby and surrounding areas over the past year.

Included in the 5 Robbery investigations during January is one where two females robbed an elderly woman in her home, taking a reported \$330.00 in cash. There are no arrests to date.
