COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The traffic fatality records were marred with the recording of 4 fatalities during the month. Two youths were killed when their vehicle slammed into a tree at a high rate of speed in a residential area; a youth pedestrian was killed after being struck by a motor vehicle when he darted across a busy street (no charges pending against the driver); an elderly lady died when the vehicle in which she was riding was struck broadside at an intersection (charges have been laid).

We had six separate reports of purse snatching from elderly ladies. Three juveniles are before the courts in connection with two of these incidents, with the remainder remaining under investigation.

An arrest was made in one of two reports of indecent assault upon female. One report of rape was proven unfounded.
