COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during March included a murder-suicide investigation, where two male companions apparently had a disagreement resulting in the one being shot with a high-powered rifle by the other, who then turned the rifle upon himself. Our members were on the balcony when shots ripped through the door and we are fortunate they were not in line with the flight of the shots.

Burnaby had its second traffic fatality of the year when a woman driver of a vehicle was struck by a second vehicle.

The suicide of a 14-year-old girl who jumped to her death off an overpass was a real tragedy, as only the week before our members were successful in thwarting the attempt by removing her from the scene after spending several hours reasoning with her. She had been released from hospital to the care of her parents.
