BEER AND WINE LICENCE  
S.G.A. RESTAURANTS COURSE LIMITED

Following is a report from the Parks & Recreation Administrator regarding the proposed sale of Municipally owned equipment to S.G.A. Restaurants. The equipment is all vital to the efficient operation of the business, and includes such items as tables, fridge, freezer, cash register, salad bar, etc. The value is based on the replacement cost and a reasonable factor for depreciation.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council approve the sale of the equipment at the Burnaby Mountain Golf Course Coffee Shop to S.G.A. Restaurants Course Limited for the sum of \$4,000.00.

Following approval of the Lessee's request to apply for a beer and wine licence, it has been ascertained that, in order to qualify for such a licence, the Lessee must own all the equipment.

Discussions have taken place with the Lessee and the Purchasing Agent, and it has been agreed that the equipment has a value of \$4,000. The Lessee has deposited a cheque for this amount with the Corporation, subject to Commission and Council approval.

At its meeting of April 20, 1977, the Parks and Recreation Commission approved the sale of the equipment for the sum of \$4,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council approve the sale of the equipment at the Burnaby Mountain Golf Course Coffee Shop to S.G.A. Restaurants Course Limited for the sum of \$4,000.
