THAT a copy of the above be sent to Mr. C. L. Crane.

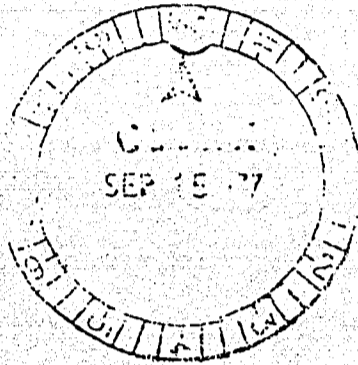

I hope you can do something about this because of the dangerous crossing and the number of accidents that have happened at this point.

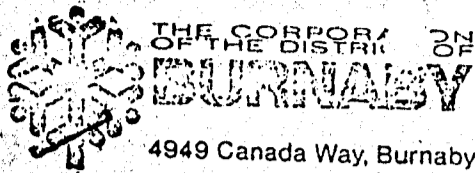
