## Re: PROPOSED PARK RESERVATIONS

Following is a report from the Parks and Recreation Administrator dated June 21, 1977 concerning reservation of certain properties for parks purposes. Item 4 in the attached report from the Director of Planning was deleted because this property is not yet registered to the Municipality. Title currently rests with the Provincial Government and we are pursuing the question of transferring it to the Municipality - at which time we would proceed with reservation. The three properties recommended for reservation at this time are owned by the Municipality.

SUBJECT: PROPOSED PARK RESERVATIONS

The <u>attached</u> report from the Director of Planning was submitted to the <u>Parks and</u> Recreation Commission at its meeting of June 1, 1977. The Commission was advised that Item 4 in the report, Keswick-Government Area park site, should be deleted at this time and only Items 1-3 of the report were recommended for park reservation.

At the June 1st meeting, the Commission approved the deletion of the Keswick-Government Area property and at the June 15th meeting, approved the reservation of the remaining park areas.

### RECOMMENDATIONS:

RE: PROPOSED PARK RESERVATIONS

As part of a continuing program aimed at the preservation of parkland, an examination has been made of existing sites to determine their suitability for a park reservation designation. This would include those park areas which have not yet been dedicated or reserved and where no further acquisitions or boundary changes are contemplated. The park areas in this category, which were all recently rezoned to P3 (R.Z. Ref. #11/77), are itemized in the following table and shown on the attached maps.





- 2. THAT the Parks and Recreation Commission recommend that the Council request the Municipal Solicitor to prepare the necessary park reservation by-laws.




