Re: FENCING ON COMMON PROPERTY LINE BETWEEN
DAVID GRAY PARK AND 7388 MCKAY AVENUE

Following is a report from the Parks and Recreation Administrator regarding the proposed construction of a fence along a line that divides private property and parkland.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council approve the expenditure of \$327.00 from the 1977 Parks and Recreation Minor Development Account to cover the Corporation's share of the cost of the installation of a common property line fence between David Gray Park and 7388 McKay Avenue.

Following a request from Mrs. E. E. Amundrud for assistance in the installation of a fence along the common property line between David Gray Park and her property at 7388 McKay Avenue, the Parks and Recreation Commission, on December 1, 1976 agreed to install such a fence providing Mrs. Amundrud paid 50% of the cost.


Mrs. Amundrud agreed, in writing, to this proposal and the Purchasing Agent called for tenders.

The low bid of \$654.00 was received from Van Can Industries. Mrs. Amundrud has submitted her share of this cost (\$327.00) and we are now ready to proceed with the work.

As the project is to be funded by 1977 Minor Development monies, it is necessary we obtain Council approval of the expenditure.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council approve the expenditure of \$327.00 from the 1977 Parks and Recreation Minor Development Account to cover the Corporation's share of the cost of the installation of a common property line fence between David Gray Park and 7388 McKay Avenue.
