Re: LETTER FROM ALYN EDWARDS
TURNING RESTRICTIONS AT CAMERON STREET AND NORTH ROAD

Appearing on the agenda for the March 28, 1977 meeting of Council is a letter from Alyn Edwards regarding the posting of signs which restrict right turns off North Road onto Cameron Street. Following is a report from the Municipal Engineer on this matter.

SUBJECT: CAMERON STREET AND NORTH ROAD

Reference: The submission of Alyn Edwards of B. C. T. V. regarding a traffic ticket received for making an illegal right turn southbound off North Road onto Cameron Street.

At the request of the residents of the Sullivan Heights Area all the local streets onto North Road were physically barricaded to prevent commuter traffic from shortcutting the area. The exception was Cameron Street where, to reduce the morning peak period commuter inbound flows, turn restrictions were used in place of barricades.

The turn restriction at Cameron and North Road is to southbound North Road traffic turning into Cameron Street and is signed "NO RIGHT TURNS 7 - 9 A.M." One sign is mounted at the North Road curb north of Cameron Street while a second sign is mounted on the signal davit along side the signal heads that control southbound North Road traffic.

We are unable to explain how motorists could miss the signing which, in our opinion, is obvious and very visible to anyone who is attentive to posted regulations.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT no action be taken on this complaint.
2. THAT the complainant be sent a copy of this report.
