SUBJECT: CIRCULAR FROM B.C. LAND COMMISSION DATED AUGUST 11, 1977

Appearing on the Council Agenda is a letter from the B.C. Land Commission dated August 11, 1977 concerned with applications for additional dwellings for non-farm use in Agricultural Land Reserve areas. The Commission is requesting that all future requests for the provision of additional dwellings for non-farm use on those properties within the Agricultural Land Reserve be made under Section 11(4) of the Land Commission Act.

While this administrative procedure has been noted, it will not be applicable within the Municipality of Burnaby in that the Municipal zoning categories in effect for Agricultural Land Reserve properties provide for no more than one residential dwelling per lot. The zoning in this respect is supportive of the Provincial policy of restricting residential expansion within designated floodplain areas which includes a majority of the Agricultural Land Reserve parcels within this Municipality.
