

Council on April 13, 1977 requested the Planning Department provide a status report on the proposed Annacis Island crossing of the Fraser River.

On April 14, 1977 the Planning Department wrote requesting the information from Mr. J. A. Stewart, P. Eng., Municipal Programs Engineer in the Highway Planning Division of the Ministry of Highways and Public Works, Victoria, B. C.

Because a written reply from Mr. Stewart's office had not been received to date, the Planning Department on May 24, 1977 telephoned Mr. Stewart on the matter. Mr. Stewart advised that he had not been successful in obtaining a meeting with the Executive Director of the Highways Planning Division, Mr. E. B. Wilkins, P. Eng., to discuss the matter. However, Mr. Stewart did advise he would continue to pursue the matter and would reply as soon as he had information to report.
