In reply to a general inquiry sent by the Union of British Columbia Municipalities to all its members, we would state that Bill 42 has already been discussed by the Housing Committee of Council. A Burnaby delegation has also discussed Bill 42 with the Department of Municipal Affairs staff and the UBCM has been informed of these discussions by copy of a letter dated May 2, 1977 from the Municipal Manager to Mr. R.W. Long, Deputy Minister for the Department of Municipal Affairs.

We would advise the UBCM that the Municipality of Burnaby does not use the Land Use Contract provisions presently in the Municipal Act, Section 702A.

It is recommended THAT a copy of this report be sent to the UBCM for its information.
