Re: LETTER FROM THE LOYAL ORANGE ASSOCIATION WHICH APPEARED ON
THE AGENDA FOR THE MAY 2, 1977 MEETING OF COUNCIL (ITEM 5f)
REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO CONDUCT A PARADE

Appearing on last week's agenda was a request from Miss E. M. Corbett, Secretary to the Committee for the Loyal Orange Association, for permission to conduct a parade on July 9, 1977. Following is a report from the Municipal Engineer on this matter.

The Parks and Recreation Administrator advises that he has no objections to the request to use Confederation Park facilities for the assembling of the parade, and in fact, in connection with Council's approval of this request from the Association, would issue the necessary allotment for these facilities.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the request from the Loyal Orange Association for permission to conduct a parade on July 9, 1977 be approved subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) the parade is conducted with accordance with Section 23 of Streets and Traffic By-law;
 - (b) approval be obtained from the Provincial Department of Highways.


