Appearing on the Agenda of the Council Meeting held on Monday, May 2, 1977, as Item 5(g), Pages 27 and 28, was a petition from Mr. Walter Utzig, 8 North Delta Avenue, Burnaby, B.C., and others, requesting that the Municipal Council not proceed with the subject Local Improvement Project which was initiated as part of the 1977 Local Improvement Programme.

The 1977 Local Improvement Programme was initiated on Wednesday, November 17, 1976, and the final date for the acceptance of opposing petitions was Friday, December 17, 1976.

The following is the result of the initiation for Project #76-102:

The Municipal Clerk's Certificate of Sufficiency dated January 8, 1977, covering the 1977 Local Improvement Programme was received by Council on January 10, 1977, and Construction By-Laws for the surviving projects were authorized to be brought forward. By-Law No. 6987 cited as "Burnaby Local Improvement Construction By-Law No. 6, 1977" which was reconsidered and adopted on January 31, 1977, authorizes the necessary construction for Project #76-102.
