
At its meeting of 1978 April 05, the Parks and Recreation Commission received a request from the Burnaby North Lawn Bowling Club for assistance in the installation of a sprinkler system to irrigate the green.

The Club has applied for a New Horizons Grant which will cover the cost of the materials, but not the labour. The quotation they have received from Pro Turf Ltd. is the one they favour and amounts to \$2,580 of which \$860 is for labour. The Parks and Recreation staff have reviewed the Club's proposal and find the irrigation system is a good one and similar to other systems which are being successfully used in neighbouring Municipalities.

The Commission approved the expenditure of \$860 for labour costs to be charged against the 1978 Minor Development Account, and would request Council approval prior to adoption of the 1978 C.I.P.

RECOMMENDATION:
