Pursuant to receipt of the information that Council had confirmed Boundary Road as a primary arterial street and had adopted the right-of-way requirement for the immediate intersection improvement needs south of Kingsway; the Parks and Recreation Commission, at its meeting of 1978 April 05, was informed that the encroachment on the Park would not disturb any large trees.

The department presented a landscape plan for the slope area which extends beyond the right-of-way acquisition area into the Park and reported that the trees affected by the encroachment would be transplanted eastward into the existing grove of trees.

The Commission approved the landscape plan.
