RE: TENDER FOR 1450 TREES - STREET TREE PLANTING PROGRAM COUNCIL MEETING 1978 12 11

Following is a report from the Purchasing Agent regarding tenders for trees.

The Parks and Recreation Administrator advises that a tight schedule exists with respect to the utilization of some of the trees, and that it would therefore be appropriate for us to take delivery as soon as possible.

A provision in the amount of \$50,000 for trees required to carry out a tree planting program is contained in the Engineering Department's 22-10-15 account.

REPORT


Requisitions were received 1978 November 23rd for 1450 Trees to be used by Parks and Recreation department for a Street Tree Planting Program for delivery to holding nursery at the Oakalla Prison site.

Tenders were received up to 15:00 h Tuesday, 1978 December 05th and opened in the presence of R. Constable, J. Hagen, B. Elliott and members of the firms bidding.

Funds have been provided in account number 22-10-15 to cover this expenditure.

A correct tabulation of the tenders received is attached.

The lowest tender numbered 4A submitted by Reid Collins Nurseries Limited includes a number of substitutes and all trees are to be supplied in a bare root condition, which is contrary to the specifications. E.J. Murray & Son Wholesale Nurseries Limited, Tender #2, offered the second lowest bid, this tender is satisfactory in all respects. Parks and Recreation staff concur with a recommendation to award a contract to this firm.
