COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS

Major incidents during the month of March included investigation of 12 robberies, one of which was declared unfounded. Two men have been charged with one, and investigation of the others continues.

The one reported rape was proven unfounded, and 6 incidents of Indecent Assault on females are under investigation. Six males are presently before the courts charged with acts of Gross Indecency after lengthy investigation.

Burnaby recorded its second traffic fatality during the month. A youth on a motorcycle was hit from the rear while stopped at an intersection. Charges have been layed against the driver of the car.
