COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

An extensive investigation during the month of November resulted in the recovery of over \$211,000 worth of electronics equipment stolen in offences throughout Burnaby and the Lower Mainland. Five males face charges of Break, Enter & Theft and Possession of Stolen Property.

Two males have been charged with the armed robberies of two Burnaby food outlets. A handgun was used in the commission of each offence.

Investigation is continuing into the rape of a twenty-one-year-old woman which occurred in a wooded area of North Burnaby.

The ninth traffic death of the year involved a 20-year-old pedestrian being struck by a car when he crossed the street in the middle of the block. No charges have been laid to date.
