RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the easement agreement with Simon Fraser University for a future water main be executed and that the related easement plan be prepared, signed and registered.

REPORT

Although the Municipal Council on 78 08 14 adopted a recommendation to not proceed with the improvement of water supply to the Centennial Pavilion, it should be noted that officials of both the University and the Corporation had already signed an agreement setting forth the conditions under which water could be taken from the University facilities and conducted on an easement to the Burnaby Mountain Pavilion through University property. This agreement included an easement to permit the Corporation to construct water facilities on Simon Fraser property as shown on the attached sketch. Whereas the agreement had been signed, the easement agreement has not been signed and the easement plan registered in the Land Registry Office.

Even though the water construction is not to proceed at the present time, it is considered desirable to complete the terms of the agreement including registering the easement, so that the Corporation would have the possibility of constructing this water facility at some future date and it is therefore our recommendation that the easement agreement be executed and the plan detailing the easement registered in the New Westminster Land Registry Office.
