COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Burnaby recorded its 3rd homicide of 1978 when a thirty-eight year old male died as a result of a single shotgun wound to the face whilst next to his vehicle parked on the street. The investigation suggests "underworld" involvement. No charges have been laid to date.

A 16-year-old American youth was arrested and charged with the Armed Robberies of three Burnaby self-serve gas stations. The accused also admitted to nine additional Armed Robberies in Vancouver.

The 6th motor vehicle fatality of 1978 was recorded when a 23-year-old female died as a result of injuries sustained when the vehicle which she was driving was struck by a second vehicle at an intersection. The accident is still under investigation.
