COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

A murder investigation, where the body of a male victim was found in an apartment block suite, has resulted in an arrest. Subject is presently awaiting court proceedings.

Two rapes were reported with one being declared "unfounded" after investigation. There has been no arrest to date in the second incident.

Six armed robberies were investigated during the month and included robbery of a male, picked up as a hitchhiker; a purse snatching from a female where \$112.00 was taken and the victim assaulted; robbery of \$80.00 at knife point from a cook in a pizza outlet; a \$300.00 robbery of a corner grocery by two youths with a firearm; robbery of a residence where the victim was assaulted by 3 males; and two youths were arrested after robbery of a delivery person at knife point.
