COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS

Burnaby recorded the first traffic fatality of the year which occurred on February 14th when a female passenger, age 49, was fatally injured in a two-car collision.

Of the 13 confirmed robberies which are under investigation, three persons have been charged. Two reported rapes (one proven unfounded) and seven incidents of indecent assaults on females have not resulted in arrests to date.

The crime pattern in the Criminal Code offences and Provincial Statutes is up slightly over last year, with Federal Statute statistics being somewhat less. Traffic accidents are just slightly less than during the first two months of 1976.
