Reference the submission from Mr. Svend J. Robinson of 7486 Kraft Place requesting a bus shelter be built for the residents of the Swedish Canadian Home and Manor.

While this request does not give a location for the requested shelter we are assuming that it is for the bus stop on the northwest corner of Duthie Avenue and Halifax Street.

The Planning Department in a recent letter to Mr. Robinson, dated 78 01 27 (copy attached), advised him that the recommendations of the Transit Committee to accept the offer of private placement of bus shelters in return for advertisement privileges had been accepted by Council and that a proposal call was being prepared for acceptable submissions.

The Planning Department advises that the proposal call will be going out shortly.

Once we have a program established for the placement of bus shelters, favourable consideration will be given to senior citizen developments as top priority locations.

Re: Municipal Bus Shelter Programme


In response to your recent telephone conversation with Mr. Craig Rowland of this Department enclosed please find:
