COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Major incidents during the month included the robbery of two banks, with investigations continuing. No arrests have been made to date. A male suspect is now before the courts after an attempted robbery of a local drugs store. A taxi driver is presently before the courts on a charge of public mischief after he falsely reported being robbed. Six other robberies were reported during the month, with charges being laid in respect to two of them. All others are being actively investigated.

Two incidents of rape were reported during April. One was proven to be unfounded and the other is still under investigation.

There were no traffic fatalities during the month.
