SUBJECT: 8200 & 8300 JOFFRE AVENUE - REQUEST FOR STREET DANCE.

Reference: the submission from Mrs. J. S. Johnson of 8278 Joffre Avenue requesting permission to hold a street dance on the captioned section of Joffre Avenue on the evening of Saturday 78 06 10.

Because of its function as a local collector together with its grade of 11^+ %, we feel that Joffre Avenue is unsuitable for the requested street dance. We did, however, look at Mapletree Lane and found that it was more suitable for the requested function because:

- It is reasonably level and paved.
- It is a dead end street and would only involve vehicular access to eight properties.
- It has less chance of attracting undesirables.

We discussed the above with Mr. and Mrs. Johnson and advised them that we would support their request for a street dance if it was held on Maple Tree Lane. We also advised them to contact those homes along Maple Tree Lane for their support of such a function. Mrs. Johnson confirmed by phone on 78 05 15 that all residents had supported the dance.

The above submission has been discussed with the R.C.M.P. and they concur with the following recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Mrs. Johnson and her neighbours be granted permission to hold their requested street dance on Mapletree Lane.
