COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

An investigation into a reported rape involving a 16-year-old Burnaby girl, who was sexually assaulted at knife point, resulted in the arrest of a 23-year-old Burnaby man, who is presently before the courts.

Two males have been charged as a result of an armed robbery in which the two assaulted and robbed the victim of \$1,600.00 while armed with a knife and a club. The offence took place at the victim's residence in North Burnaby.

Arrests of one male adult and one juvenile male were made after an incident on September 4th in which a corner store was robbed of \$247.00. A meat cleaver was used in the commission of the offence.
