Re: 1977 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
SPORTSFIELD LIGHTING

Following is a report from the Parks and Recreation Administrator regarding lighting for sports fields.

A tabulation of the tenders received is attached.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council authorize a contract with United Power Limited for the installation of floodlights at Wesburn Park (soccer field), Confederation Park (soccer field and Lacrosse box) and Edmonds School (soccer field and pre-ducting) in the amount of \$81,751.00; and
2. THAT Council authorize the Purchasing Agent to negotiate with United Power Limited for a firm price for the installation of four additional light poles at Edmonds School and that this be added to the above contract; and
3. THAT Council approve the expenditure of \$12,000 from Eastburn N.I.P. funds as a contribution to the cost of lighting Edmonds School soccer field.

A total amount of \$98,000.00 was included in the 1977 Capital Improvement Program for the lighting of various fields. As per Commission policy, the community groups requesting the lighting are responsible for 25% of the cost of installation and design fees.

Shaflik Engineering Consultants have designed the lighting systems at a cost of \$4,600.00 and tenders have been called resulting in ten bids ranging from \$81,751.00 to \$130,647.12 being received.

The low bid of \$81,751.00 submitted by United Power Limited meets all specifications and is broken down as follows:

Wesburn Park soccer field	\$22,346.00
Confederation Park soccer field	28,007.00
Confederation Park lacrosse box	12,284.00
Edmonds School soccer field lighting	15,072.00
Edmonds School soccer field pre-ducting	4,042.00

In the case of Edmonds School, the Edmonds Soccer Club was only able to provide 25% of the cost of installing lighting poles on one side of the field and Eastburn N.I.P. Committee had agreed to pay for the pre-ducting to run to the opposite side for future poles. In view of the good price received from United Power Ltd., the Commission received a request to have four more poles installed at Edmonds School with a commitment from the Eastburn N.I.P. Committee to pay a total of \$12,000.00 toward the pre-ducting and the additional poles.

At a meeting held at noon on 1978 February 20, the Parks and Recreation Commission received the above information together with a report that an estimate of \$16,000.00 had been obtained from United Power Ltd. for the additional lights. The Commission approved acceptance of the tender of \$81,751.00

from United Power Ltd. and that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to negotiate with this company for a cost on the extra poles and that this be added to the contract.

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
All four community groups have agreed to pay their share and cheques are being processed at this time; two have already been received.

Funding of the project will, therefore, be as follows:

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2. THAT Council authorize the Purchasing Agent to negotiate with United Power Limited for a firm price for the installation of four additional light poles at Edmonds School and that this be added to the above contract.
3. THAT Council approve the expenditure of \$12,000.00 from Eastburn N.I.P. funds as a contribution to the cost of lighting Edmonds School soccer field.
