COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Two Coquitlam men have been charged as a result of an Attempted Armed Robbery of a north-side grocery store. The culprits were armed with a knife and a billy-club during the commission of the offence. Also charged with Attempted Armed Robbery are one adult and two juvenile males. The three were arrested outside a north-side grocery store immediately after the offence, and a sawed-off .22 cal. rifle was involved.

The overall crime statistics for the 10-month period in 1978 closely parallels the figures recorded during the same period in 1977. Traffic deaths, property damage and total accidents show a slight decrease.
