COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

- During July one suspect was arrested and charged with the stabbing of a female in Central Park.
- Charges were also laid against an inmate of L.M.R.C.C. as a result of an incident in which a guard was stabbed.
- On July 21st, Jubilee Credit Union, 4649 Kingsway, was robbed by a lone male armed with a handgun. Amount taken was \$2,611. A suspect has been arrested and charges have been laid.
- Burnaby recorded its fourth and fifth motor vehicle fatalities this year when a car with five occupants drove off the Burlington Northern Railway overpass in the 2500 block Willingdon Avenue. Three surviving passengers sustained serious injuries.
