RE: LETTER FROM MR. GORDON C. LEWIS 7230 BRAESIDE DRIVE, BURNABY BARNET MARINE PARK

Appearing on the agenda for the 1978 August 28 meeting of Council is a letter from Mr. Gordon C. Lewis regarding the Barnet Marine Beach Park.

With respect to the parking area, we have not used road salt or oil spray because many users of the beach walk in this area, some in bare feet. This area, however, is in the construction program which calls for black topping in 1979.

Mr. Lewis has suggested that some type of device be used to record how many people use the beach facility. The Parks and Recreation Administrator feels that this is not necessary in view of the fact that the counts now taken by a watchman with pencil and paper are efficient and reliable; there is no need, therefore, to adopt a different method of keeping count at this time.
