COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

During June two suspects were arrested and charged with two separate accounts of armed robberies of banks, where a total of \$5,100. was taken. Charges were laid against a 'sniper' who injured two pedestrians when shot at by a .22 cal. rifle from an apartment. Both victims have recovered. The third motor vehicle fatality of the year was investigated during June. It revealed that a sole occupant of a vehicle drove over an embankment during the early morning hours and collided with a tree.
