REPORT

Commencing 1978 December O1, the Ministry of Health will no longer be supplying Health Departments with free vaccines and biologicals for this purpose. In the past we have been able to supply Smallpox and Typhoid vaccines at no charge.

As of 1978 December Ol, we will have to charge \$3.00 per shot to those people requesting immunizations for travel purposes. This charge is to cover the cost of providing the vaccine. This does not affect our regular immunization programs for Diphtheria, Tetanus, Polio and Pertussis for children or immunization for adults for Diphtheria, Tetanus or Polio which will still be provided free of charge, even if these are for travel purposes.

This is for the information of Council.
