COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The calendar year end statistical pattern shows a slight decrease in the overall 'offence' category, but an improved picture in the 'clearance' category. The 1977 traffic fatalities totalled 15 versus 5 last year and 20 in 1975. Increases likewise are recorded in the "persons injured" and "Property damage" categories.

Two fatals during December; one involved the death of the driver of a vehicle in a 3-car collision, and in the other a pedestrian was struck down. Charges have been laid in the latter incident.

There were 12 reported robberies during December: seven persons are before the courts in connection with five of these investigations. Two reports of rape remain under investigation.
