RE: ROYAL CANADIAN AIR CADETS 759 SQUADRON - Cont'd.

Captain Roden advised that the Knights of Columbus, Council 5423, which is identified on the cadets letterhead as its Sponsoring Committee, helps in the raising of funds for a variety of operational purpose but has not been involved in the past in a commitment to the provision of space for the cadets.

Captain Roden's letter to Council, of 1978 January 23, was exploratory in the sense of asking advice on how to go about identifying space to be used by the 759 Squadron. Captain Roden has been advised of the current status of the Corporation's Parks and Recreation construction program, and we believe that the matter requires further discussion between the Squadron and staff. Some of the alternatives to be explored are: the level of self-help of which the Squadron is capable; utilization of present or future recreation buildings; the impact of the North Burnaby Neighbourhood Improvement Program, and cooperation with the 637 Squadron which operates in South Burnaby. Council should note that staff have held such discussions with the 637 Squadron who finds itself in a similar, uncertain position regarding accommodation.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. THAT the Royal Canadian Air Cadets, 759 Squadron, be advised of the contents of this report.
- 2. THAT the Squadron be referred to staff for further discussion regarding its accommodation needs.
