COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

Seven robberies reported during January included robbery at a motel, robbery of occupants at a private residence, robbery with violence of a young male by five culprits, and a female being robbed of her purse after alighting from a bus. Three persons are before the courts in connection with one incident, with the remainder continuing under investigation.

The number of Criminal Code cases are down slightly over last year, but the clearance rate is up somewhat which is a healthy trend. The traffic accident total is down slightly over January 1977.

The two reports of rape were proven unfounded.
