

REPORT

The captioned enquiry came about as the result of a complaint from a resident of Erickson Drive who was experiencing difficulty entering Cameron Street from Erickson Drive due to sight obstruction by parked vehicles on the south side of Cameron. In the past week this has been compounded by Municipal work crews installing water and sewer connections to the new Burnaby Library site. The above mentioned work, which was signed and controlled by flag men, has now been completed. To resolve the problem of vehicles obstructing the sight lines along Cameron Street we have ordered a parking restriction "NO PARKING ANYTIME" on the south curb of Cameron 40 metres east and west of Erickson Drive.

Upon completion of the library/recreation centre we intend to prohibit parking on the north curb of Cameron Street opposite Erickson Drive to give extended sight distance to the anticipated heavy pedestrian traffic crossing Cameron Street.
