REPORT

On 1979 February 14 Council met with the School Board. One of the items discussed was the format of the Municipal tax bill. For many years the Public Schools Act has required "that each tax demand notice and each taxation notice shall clearly set forth the total amount of taxes for school purposes levied on each property-owner, the amount of those taxes payable by the Province on behalf of the property-owner (if eligible) pursuant to the provisions of the Provincial Home-Owner Grant Act, and the net amount of school taxes payable by the property-owner."

More than ten years ago it was a requirement of the Municipal Act that all municipalities have a common form of tax bill which did indeed show the application of the Home-Owner Grant applied to the extent possible against school taxes but this requirement was removed, presumably because of the technical difficulties in carrying it out.

Notwithstanding, the School Board requested that consideration be given to having the requirements of the School Act carried out and offered to pay for the capital cost of developing such a bill.

As Burnaby had recently acquired a new computer possessing much greater capabilities than the previous one, Council instructed the Municipal Treasurer to take the matter in hand. Attached is a sample of the bill that has been developed and which is in the process of being mailed to taxpayers.

The frontpiece shows the taxes applicable with the Provincial Home-Owner Grant applied firstly to school taxes and secondly to other taxes. In the sample it will be noted that the whole of the \$380.00 grant is applied to school taxes in the column headed "Basic Grant" and that \$383.26 of the \$580.00 grant is applied to school taxes and \$196.74 is pro rated to other taxes in the column headed "Added Grant".

The obverse side gives instructions on the payment of taxes.

The \$380.00 grant applies to all eligible home owners. The \$580.00 grant applies to eligible home owners over age 65 or those homeowners in receipt of Handicapped Persons Income Assistance or War Veterans Allowance.

A mockup of the tax bill was placed before the School Board on 1979 February 27 and met with their approval.

In the ordinary course of events, the Coquitlam tax bill would have been adapted to our use, as was their tax system generally. It cost \$2,590 in consultant's time to develop and program the new bill. An invoice for this sum has been sent to the School Board.

The bill itself has other interesting points. It lists the six taxing authorities and their mill rates. It shows the actual assessed values of property and the taxable values as well. It will show separately the water, sewer parcel tax, sewer use tax and the individual local improvements, and, of course, arrears and delinquent taxes, penalties and interest, where applicable. In previous years it has been necessary to combine some of this information.
