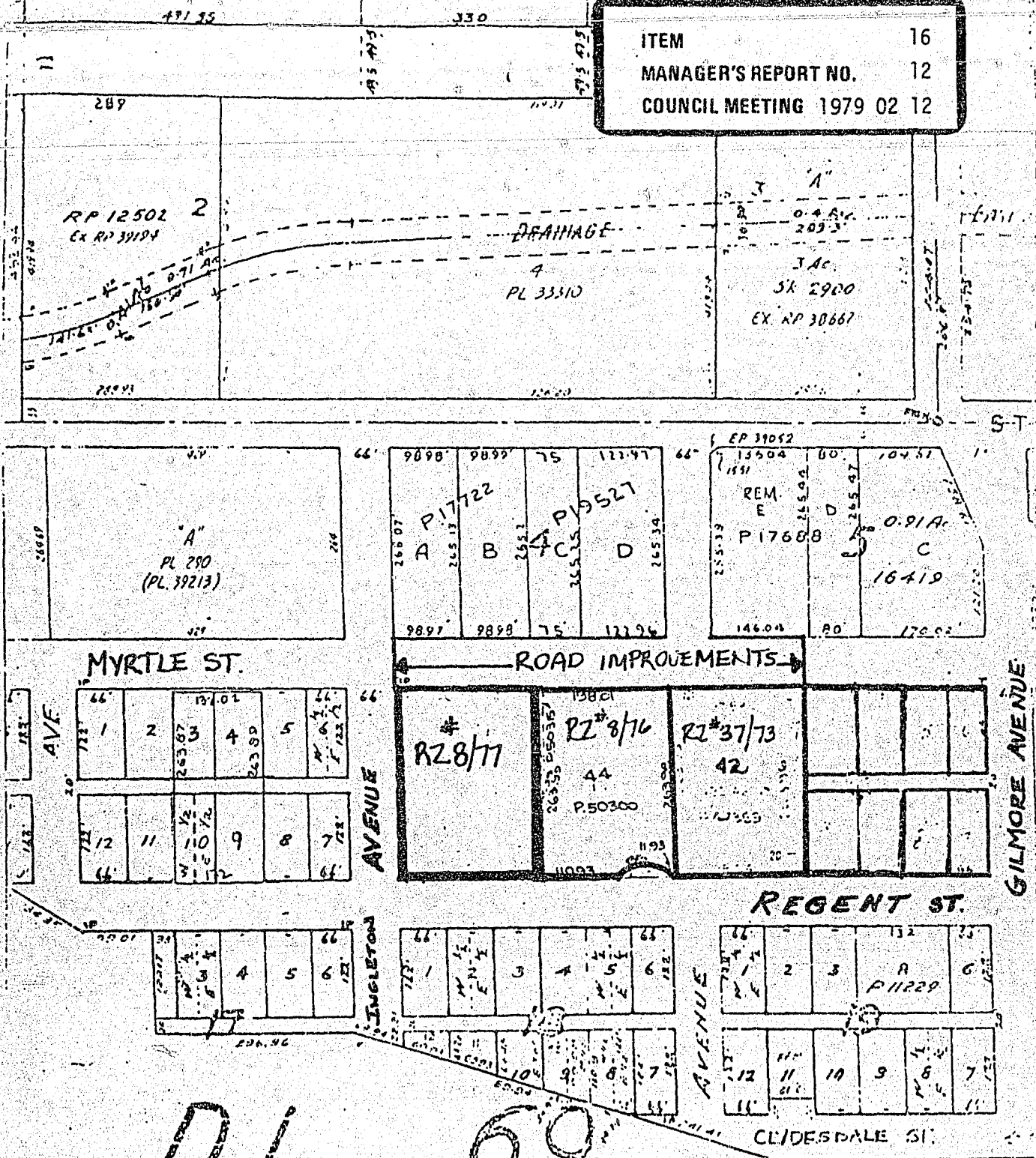
1. THAT Council authorize the release of the necessary monies from the Land Development and Assembly Fund to be allocated for the improvement of Myrtle Street as described in this report.

REPORT

1.0 BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- 1.1 In consideration of Rezoning Reference #37/73 involving Municipally-owned properties that were intended to be developed for light industrial uses as part of a land exchange between the Municipality and Vanant Development Company, Council on 1973 October 01 authorized the expenditure of \$88,100 for preservicing the site (see attached sketch). These monies were intended to be recovered from the sale of Municipal properties located to the west of the site which would also be serviced by the works to be constructed. Subsequently, Council on 1976 June 21 gave Final Adoption to Rezoning Reference #8/76 involving the sale of the adjacent Municipal properties.
