Re: BOUNDARY ROAD

The following report from the Municipal Engineer pertains to the work that is to be done relative to the upgrading of Boundary Road. Contained in the report is the motion that Burnaby Council passed when the matter was last considered on 1979 July 03.

After the action taken by Burnaby Council on July 03, the Municipal Manager was advised of the proposal by the City of Vancouver wherein the vast majority of the work to be performed would be contracted out by public tender. Because the relatively small remaining amount of work is of the type that is normally done by municipal forces, the proposal called for this portion to be carried out by crews that are employed by the City.

The Municipal Manager interpreted that this proposal met the real intent of the motion by Council. The two week intervals between meetings precluded a timely referral of this matter back to Council for consideration. The Municipal Manager did, however, bring it to the attention of the Transportation Committee at its meeting on July 05. The Committee's discussion concluded with a concurrence to the effect that the approach as proposed by Vancouver should be adopted.

The Municipal Manager therefore authorized the work to proceed on this basis, and instructed the Municipal Engineer to satisfy himself that the estimates for the work to be undertaken by the City's forces were acceptable to him. Following is his report in this regard.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT the recommendation of the Municipal Engineer be adopted; and
2. THAT the action of the Municipal Manager be ratified; and
3. THAT a copy of this report be sent to the Vancouver City Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Municipal Council receive this report as explanation as to the basis on which Burnaby will be expected to share with Vancouver the proposed construction work on Boundary Road for 1979.

REPORT

When the Municipal Council on 79 07 03 approved of proceeding with Vancouver on the upgrading of Boundary Road between Marine Way and Imperial Street, the following motion was approved arising out of Council's discussion:

"That the cost sharing between the Municipality of Burnaby and the City of Vancouver for this project be based on a bid tender for the grubbing, clearing, and cutting of the Boundary Road alignment."

We have been in touch with the City of Vancouver to find out what their intentions were in this regard and they have advised us that the \$412,000 of work proposed for 1979 will be distributed as follows:

- 1. Preparation of the detour route - \$ 96,000
- 2. Excavation west side north and south of Marine Drive - \$258,000


B. Proposed to be done by Consulting (Three Proposals)

- Design of Marine Drive structure - \$ 18,000

C. Proposed for Vancouver Forces

- Clearing and grubbing of right-of-way - \$ 40,000
- \$412,000

In connection with the work proposed by the City of Vancouver forces we have reviewed the \$40,000 proposed for clearing and grubbing of the right-of-way and are in agreement that this is a reasonable amount.
