COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

A Burnaby man has been charged with Attempted Murder and three counts of Forcible Confinement as a result of a shooting incident during November. The suspect was later apprehended after having threatened that he would not be taken alive, which involved special precautions on the part of the investigators.

An elderly Burnaby resident became the eleventh traffic fatality of 1979 when he was struck and killed while attempting to cross a major traffic artery during darkness. The driver of the vehicle has not been charged.
