REPORT

BACKGROUND

With respect to an engiry on the status of school facilities for the Burnaby 200 area, Council at its meeting of 1979 November 26 received a report from the Planning Department and adopted the recommendation contained in the report which stated:

"THAT Final Adoption of Rezoning Reference #34/79 be only granted after written confirmation has been received from the Burnaby School Board that commitments have been achieved with the Ministry of Education for the provision of school facilities when required by the student population in the Burnaby 200 Community Plan area."

A meeting of Ministry of Education officials, Burnaby School Board staff and Planning Department staff held on 1979 December 10 was very positive and all participants acknowledged the high priority for a school facility in Burnaby 200.

In reply to Council's recommendation, the Secretary-Treasurer of the School Board has submitted the attached letter dated 1979 December 12. The letter states that the School Board on 1979 December 11 approved the following recommendation:

Concerning the recommendation contained in Item No. 6 of the Manager's Report No. 81 approved by Council 1979 November 26, following is an extract from the secretary-treasurer's report containing a recommendation and approved by this Board 1979 December 11:

"The Corporation of the Municipality of Burnaby has requested written assurance from the Board that the School District will initiate a capital construction project leading to construction of a school in the "Project 200" development area on Burnaby Mountain. In 1975 the Roard began the process leading to construction of a school in Project 200. In 1977 this plan had to be placed on hold because development had not proceeded as projected.

"A joint planning session with staff from the Municipal Planning Department and Ministry of Education officials confirmed the need to proceed. Ministry of Education officials (Mr. B. Morin and Mr. M. Harrison) concur with the need and assure us that they give favourable consideration to initiation of this project.
