**COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:**

A twenty-year-old Ontario resident became Burnaby's seventh motor vehicle fatality of 1979 when the motorcycle on which he was a passenger went out of control on a curve. Both riders were thrown from the vehicle and were wedged under a parked truck. The operator of the motorcycle sustained a fractured skull and broken legs.

The arrest of three Burnaby residents has resulted in the solving of 41 "green thumb" burglaries (entering homes when occupants are in their yards) committed between March and June of this year. Charges have been laid against all three.

Investigation is continuing into two gun-point armed robberies. In one, the attendant of a self service gas station was robbed of \$430.00. In the second, the proprietor of a restaurant was robbed of the evening's receipts in the parking lot of the establishment.
