In response to the above submission we will be posting, for a period of six months, a directional sign indicating that Ardingley Avenue and Darnley Street can be reached via Laurel Street off Norland Avenue. This signing is for the benefit of regular users who normally entered the area via Ardingley Avenue at Sprott. Newcomers to the area will be in the same position as newcomers to dozens of other streets in Burnaby that are well off the main arterials e.g. Conrad Street, Alaska Street, Express Street, Venture Street, in that it will be their responsibility to seek direction by either road map or enquiry.
