COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:


The lone occupant of a passenger car died when his vehicle collided head-on with a school bus in the 5500 block Canada Way, bringing the total number of traffic fatalities for 1978 to nine. The driver of the bus and sixteen passengers were treated for various injuries.

The 1978 year-end statistics record a reasonable consistency in many areas compared to the previous year. Total offences show a decrease, with the major difference being in the Provincial Statute enforcement. The total clearance in Criminal Code and Federal statute area remained almost parallel, drinking driving offences record a decrease from 985 to 846, and traffic fatalities totalled 9 in 1978 compared to 13 in 1977. Total accidents reported are down by 165, however, reported traffic injuries are up over the 1977 figure.

Investigation is continuing into the armed robbery of a female pedestrian in a north-side school yard.

Escapes: L.M.R.C.C. 2 males, at large.
