
Recommendation:

The Canadian Parks & Recreation Association is a national organization representative of municipal parks and recreation departments. The Parks & Recreation Commission has maintained beneficial relationship with this organization for several years. The program content of the conference covers a number of current parks and recreation concerns such as maintenance management, downtown beautification, municipal marinas, risk recreation activities, Proposition 13 and its effect for municipalities, design of new facilities - energy conservation and cost saving strategies for parks operations.
