COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

A New Westminster man has been charged with two counts of Attempted Murder, and four of his associates with various weapons and property charges, as a result of a shooting incident. Two Burnaby R.C.M.P. members checked a vehicle bearing Texas licence plates when one of the occupants fired a shotgun, wounding both. In an ensuing encounter, the suspect was wounded and taken into custody.

A Burnaby resident has been charged with the Armed Robbery of a local pharmacy, during April. The premises was robbed of over \$400.00 in cash in addition to a quantity of narcotics.

The driver of the car involved in a motor vehicle accident in February, 1979 has died in hospital this month as a result of injuries sustained. The victim was predeceased in March by a passenger in the vehicle.
