RE: LETTER FROM DR. M. KABURDA WHICH APPEARED ON THE AGENDA FOR THE 1979 MAY 14 MEETING OF COUNCIL (ITEM 4d) BARNET ROAD BARRICADES

Attached is a copy of the letter from Dr. M. Kaburda which appeared on last week's agenda. It will be recalled that Council has already dealt with the correspondent's opinion that surveys carried out by the municipality are incomplete. Comments on his other two points are contained in the attached report from the Municipal Engineer.

For the record, following are the recommendations of the Traffic Safety Committee which were unanimously adopted by Council on May 07:

- "1. THAT Council approve the closure of Barnet Road at the Barnet Highway.
- 2. THAT Council approve the closure of the lane between Barnet Road and Barnet Highway in conjunction with the closure of Barnet Road at the Barnet Highway."



Dear Madam/Gentlemen:



1. With full respect to the majority of the council who, in their wisdom, decided to close the aforementioned street and back alley at Inlet Drive, I wish to, on behalf of the Westridge Concerned Citizens Association, reiterate our position that the questionnaire carried out of "those persons resident in the area who would be directly affected by this closure" was incomplete.

We submit that the statistical data submitted be declared invalid and that it be rescinded from the Traffic Safety Committee report.

We consider the following residents to be directly affected by the closure in a much greater capacity than the residents of both sides of Brayside Street. In addition to the residents of Barnet Road between Ridge Drive and Inlet Drive, we consider residents of Inlet Drive whose back alley will be blockaded, both sides of Ridge Drive between Duthie and Inlet Drive and both sides of Duthie between Hastings and Ridge Drive should have been polled as they would be directly affected by this closure.

It is our contention that this closure will bring complaints from other affected residents. The results of the survey should not be available for any future reference as they do not represent the area in question, nor do they express the instructions of the council.

In our opinion the survey was not correctly carried out and therefore it should not be allowed to tarnish the council's integrity.

2. With reference to the May 7, 1979 agenda, item 6, page 5 it appears the council approved a closure of a non existent

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intersection. Our maps show that the Barnet Road and the Barnet lane meet at Inlet Drive, which in turn merges with the Barnet Highway. Would it be possible to confirm this with the Engineering department and make the necessary corrections.

Our association, with this letter, wishes to initiate a petition of the council requesting the council to consider the realignment of the Barnet Highway with respect to its connection to Hastings Street..We would like to see Inlet Drive maintained as a residential street and not be incorporated into the proposed Barnet Highway extension.
