COMMENTS ON CRIME TRENDS AND POLICING PROBLEMS:

The arrest of a Burnaby resident on a charge of possessing stolen property has resulted in solving 204 breaking and entering offences committed throughout the Lower Mainland during the last five years. Eighteen of the offences occurred in Burnaby.

Two self-serve gas stations were victimized by armed robbers during September. In both instances a handgun was used and the net proceeds totalled less than \$300.00.

Investigation is continuing into the armed robbery of a Burnaby credit union. The culprit, armed with a handgun, fled the premise with over \$2,000.

Two Vancouver females face charges after an unsuccessful robbery attempt of a cab driver. One of the females was armed with a can of mace during the commission of the offence.
