REPORT

Appearing on the Council Agenda are two items of correspondence dated 1979 October 15 requesting Municipal approval for Class "A" Liquor Licences. Brentwood Lanes Ltd. is requesting that the lounge area facilities for the present dining room/holding bar be increased from 25 to 45 seats. It should be noted that approval under a Class "B" Liquor Licence was granted for the existing 25 seats. The other request is for approval of 100 seats in the lounge of the newly-constructed Brentwood Racquetball Club.

In order that each of the proposals can be evaluated on its own merit, it will be necessary to obtain comments from the relevant Municipal Departments including the Burnaby Detachment of the R.C.M.P. Therefore, upon completion of the Planning Department's assessment of the above-noted liquor licence applications, a further, detailed report on each application will be submitted to Council for consideration.
